## History of 1st September

- ◆ **1956** : Life Insurance Corporation of India was established.
- ◆ **1956** : It became a union territory after the reorganization of states
- ◆ **1926** : Vijaydan Detha, a famous mathematician of Rajasthani language, was born.
- ◆ **1574** : The third Guru of the Sikhs, Guru Amardas Ji, died.
- ◆ **1947** : Indian Standard Time was mentioned.
- ◆ **1964** : Indian Oil Refinery and Indian Oil Company were merged to form Indian Oil Corporation.

## Current Affairs Related to 1st September

- ◆ **Maharashtra government has decided to implement the Integrated Pension Scheme.** It will become effective from March 2025. UPS will pay 50% of the employee's average salary for the last 12 months as pension. Maharashtra Cabinet also approved several other initiatives including the Rs 7000 crore Nar Par Girna river linking project. The river interlinking project will benefit agricultural land by providing irrigation to about 50,000 hectares of land in Nashik and Jalgaon districts. The state government will also raise Rs 5000 crore through equity and bonds for the Thane project.
- ◆ **In a significant step ahead of the October 2024 assembly elections, Maharashtra became** the first state to implement a pension scheme for its employees, just hours after the central government launched the scheme. This decision is expected to benefit about 13.5 lakh state employees in various districts including acquired and subsidized industries, non-agricultural industries and district councils.
- ◆ **Satish Kumar has been appointed Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Railway Board.** He is an officer of the Indian Railway Management Service. He is currently serving as a member. He will replace Jaya Verma Sinha. His tenure will start from September
- ◆ **A 1987 batch officer general of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police has been appointed as additional** component of the force guarding the Line of Actual Control brought from China. This is the second time that a non-I PSC officer has been appointed to this post. An order issued by the Home Ministry states that apart from Railways, another officer IG Jaspal Singh is going for recruitment to the rank of ADG for the year 2024.
- ◆ **Amid Pakistan's support for terrorist attacks in Jammu and Kashmir, India and Indonesia** have condemned it being used as a conspiracy to fuel cross-border terrorism. The luggage of militants from across the border was picked up in the sixth meeting of the India-Indonesia Joint Working Group on Mob Incitement held in Jakarta.
- ◆ **WHO has launched a six-month global plan to deal with the Mpxo outbreak.** The objective of this scheme is to reduce human-to-human transmission of Mpxo. The plan for this involves coordinated global, regional and national efforts. This scheme will run from September 2024 to February 2025. It envisages financing of US\$ 135 million. The plan includes strategic vaccination efforts for those at highest risk of interrupting the infection chain.
- ◆ **Sanjeev Raina was appointed Additional Director General in ITBP.** This is the second time that a non-IPS officer has been promoted to the post of ADG in ITBP. This is the second highest post in the force after DG. Sanjeev Raina is a 1987 batch ITBP officer. Raina will serve in the new position for more than a month. He is going to retire next month. Raina is working as Inspector General in the Central Zone Headquarters of ITBP in Bhopal.
- ◆ **The Department of Posts has signed an MoU with the National Remote Sensing Centre.** This MoU has been signed to establish a standardized, geocoded addressing system in India. This MoU was signed ahead of the first National Space Day. Under this partnership, a standardized, geo-coded addressing system will be developed to simplify citizen-centric delivery of public and private services in India. The Department of Posts and National Remote Sensing Center will change the addressing system in India.
- ◆ **India's space sector has directly contributed about \$24 billion to India's GDP in the last decade.** It has supported 96000 jobs in the public and private sectors. \$13 billion has been invested in the space sector in the last decade. India is the 8th largest space economy in the world. There are now 700 companies in the Indian space sector, including 200 startups.

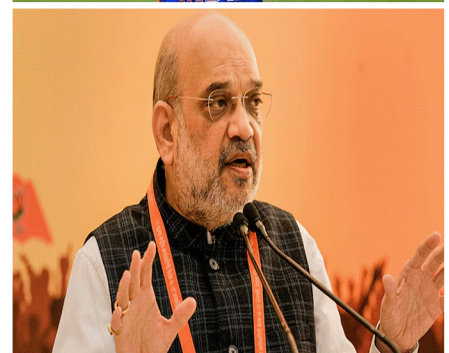
