- ◆ **1977** : **Shyamlal Gupta Parshad**, the author of **Vijay Vishva Dhwaja Priya**, passed away.
- ◆ **1894** : The country's **fourth President VV Giri** was born.
- ◆ **1979** : Satellite **Salvi-3** was launched.
- ◆ **2010** : India successfully tested **Gagan**, a satellite positioning system based **aircraft navigation** system.
- ◆ **1511** : **Portuguese** troops captured a part of the Malaysian state of **Malacca**.

Current Affairs Related to 10th August 2024

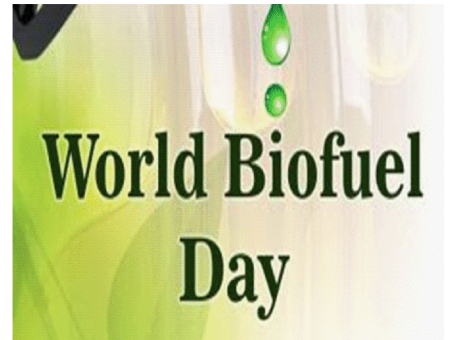
- ◆ **Reserve Bank of India issued norms for uniformity in the treatment of bad and doubtful loan reserves for prudential purposes.** These revised norms will be for urban co-operative banks, state co-operative banks and central co-operative banks. This will come into effect with immediate effect. The Reserve Bank of India has also laid down specific steps to facilitate reform and smooth transition to the accounting standard compliance approach. The Reserve Bank of India directed that to make provisions for NPAs till March 31, 2025, appropriation should be made directly from the Reserve Bank of India account or general reserves.
- ◆ **Virasat is a fortnight long exhibition dedicated to celebrating the 10th National Handloom Day.** It is being organized by the National Handloom Development Corporation Limited under the aegis of the Ministry of Textiles, Government of India. Virasat will end on August 16. The heritage exhibitions are an extension of the celebrations around the National Handloom Day held last year. The Swadeshi movement started on 7 August 1905.
- ◆ **DRDO and BDL have received approval from the Indian Air Force for the production of 200 Astra air-to-air missiles for their Sukhoi-30 and LCA Tejas fighter aircraft.** Defense Research and Development Organization is the development agency for this project, Bharat Dynamics Limited is the production agency for it. The Defense Acquisition Council has approved the program for the Indian Air Force and Indian Navy. Under this, 248 missiles were expected to be produced for the Indian Air Force and Indian Navy in 2022-2023.
- ◆ **Senior Lieutenant General Hoang Xuan Chien, Deputy Minister of National Defense of Vietnam, and Shri Giridhar Aramane, Defense Secretary, co-chaired the meeting.** Both sides during the meeting acknowledged the progress in their relations following the signing of the Joint Vision Statement on India-Vietnam Defense Partnership towards 2030 in June 2022.
- ◆ **India is conducting its first multinational air exercise Tarang Shakti 2024 from August 6 to September 14.** About 30 countries will participate in this exercise. And out of these, ten countries will participate in the exercise with their fighter planes. The exercise is being conducted in two phases with the objective of showcasing India's defense capabilities and providing a platform to promote interoperability between the participating armies. The first phase is being held in Sular, Tamil Nadu from 6th to 14th August and the second phase will be held in Jodhpur, Rajasthan from 29th August to 14th September.
- ◆ **President Draupadi Murmu went on a two-day visit to Philly.** He addressed the Parliament of Fiji and recalled 75 years of diplomatic relations between India and Fiji. President Murmu thanked the Government of Fiji for their support for the Aditya L1 mission. President Murmu recalled the support provided by India to Fiji through the Vaccine Maitri Initiative during the COVID-19 crisis.
- ◆ **Ms. Rekha Sharma, Chairperson, National Commission for Women, in partnership with Cyber ??Peace Foundation, inaugurated the Digital Shakti Kendra.** The aim of the center is to increase awareness among people about cyber crimes. It will provide vital technical support for filing and resolving complaints. The Commission highlighted how important this program is to give women the confidence to use technology safely and effectively.
- ◆ **The Karnataka government constituted a task force to remove encroachment in the forests and Western Ghats.** This task force has been formed to remove illegal resorts, homestays and all forest encroachments throughout the Western Ghats. This task force has been formed under the leadership of Principal Chief Conservator of Forest and Chief of Forest Force. Additional Chief Secretary of Forest Department has issued orders to remove all forest encroachments in the Western Ghats region.

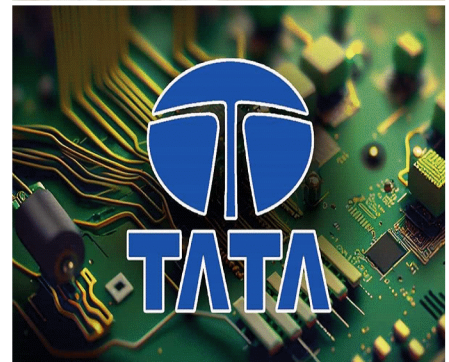
