History of 10th November

- ◆ **2001** : Indian Prime Minister **Atal Bihari Vajpayee** inaugurated the **United Nations General Assembly**.
- ◆ **2008** : Agreement on **India-Qatar relations** was signed. Both countries signed a defence and **security agreement**.
- ◆ **1750** : **Tipu Sultan**, the ruler of **Mysore** state, was born.
- ◆ **1908** : One of the immortal martyrs, **Kanailal Dutt**, died after being hanged for the **success** of India.
- ◆ **1985** : **Bill Gates** launched **Windows 1.0**.

Current Affairs Related to 10th November 2024

- ◆ **India has taken a significant step towards realising Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision** of hosting the prestigious Olympic Games in 2036. The Indian Olympic Association issued a letter of intent to the IOC on 1 October 2023, as part of its ongoing efforts to raise India's global sporting profile. This will be India's first time hosting an Olympic Games, fulfilling a long-standing desire of the country's citizens.
- ◆ **Indian Navy launched the third edition of Ocean Summit, its flagship initiative for maritime security** in the Indian Ocean Region. The summit was held on the theme, Reducing Maritime Security Competition to Training Cooperation in the IOR. Senior leaders from 10 countries attended the summit and shared the maritime torch to discuss collective efforts.
- ◆ **Indian professional Mandeep Jangra won the world featherweight world title by defeating Britain's Conor McIntosh** in the Cayman Islands. The 31-year-old Jangra, trained by former Olympic silver medalist Roy Jones Jr., has suffered only one defeat in his professional career so far. He had the upper hand against the British fighter in most of the rounds.
- ◆ **The Indian Space Research Organisation launched the European Union's Proba 3 solar observation mission** from Sriharikota in December. The satellite, which is a Sriharikota reach pad, is designed to study the sun's flux corona, an important principle of solar science. This is India's third space cooperation project with the European Union, following the launch of Proba 1 and Proba 2.
- ◆ **In Madhya Pradesh, 35% of the seats are vacant for women in all the recruitments** of the state government in the meeting of Chief Minister Mohan Yadav held in Nashik. This decision was taken during the meeting held in Madhya Pradesh Ministry.
- ◆ **In Indo-Kazakh cooperation, IREL Limited, a CPSCU under the Department of Atomic Energy and Ust Kamennyogorsk NMA Ore Magnesium Plant JSC of Kazakhstan have established a joint venture** under the Department of Atomic Energy. The MoU has been signed with the objective of producing MOM slag in Odisha, India. The details were signed by Dr. Dipendra Singh, CMD, IREL and Dr. Mamutova, Secretary, Scout Dai, President of UKTMP.
- ◆ **IDFC FIRST Bank in partnership with SWIFT has introduced a revolutionary Real Time Business Service** for international money transfers. The service is available on the Bank's award winning mobile app and internet platform, and makes IDFC FIRST Bank the first Indian bank to offer end to end traceability for cross border transfers. The service is a manifestation of the Bank's customer first philosophy, which seeks to harness the power and speed of digital payments such as UPI and IMPS in international transactions.
- ◆ **Donald Trump won a crucial victory in Wisconsin, with 276 electoral seats, well above the 270 needed, and regained the White House** as the 47th President of the United States. Addressing a passionate crowd in West Palm Beach, Florida, Trump called on the American people to have extraordinary respect, and acknowledged their special place as he became first the 45th and now the 47th President of the United States.
- ◆ **The Union Ministry of Social Justice and Constitutional Affairs inaugurated the Shilp Samagam Mela 2024** in a grand manner at Delhi Haat New Delhi. The festival is attended by national level finance and development corporations National Sanitation Workers Finance and Development Corporation and National Sanitation Workers Finance and Development Corporation. The objective of this fair is to provide a platform to the craftsmen for their crafts and sculptures, so as to promote economic inclusion and cultural innovation.

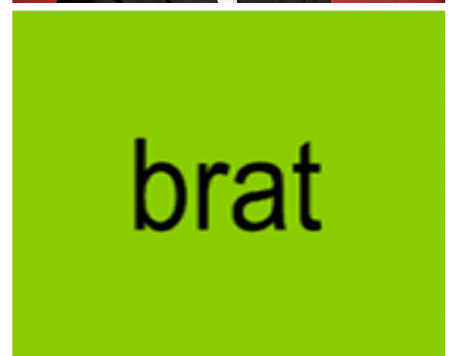
