



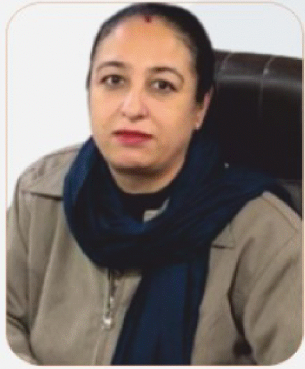

History of 28th September

- ◆ **1837** : The last Mughal emperor **Bahardu Shah II** ruled Delhi.
- ◆ **1907** : Great freedom fighter **Bhagat Singh** was born.
- ◆ **2015** : Famous Hindi poet **Viren Dangwal** passed away.
- ◆ **1929** : Indian playback singer **Lata Mangeshkar** was born.
- ◆ **1837** : The 18th emperor of the Mughal dynasty **Akbar II** passed away.
- ◆ **2006** : **Taliban** announced that **Laden** was alive.

Current Affairs Related to 28th September 2024

- ◆ **SpaceX plans to send five unmanned Starship missions to Mars in the next two years**, according to CEO Elon Musk. Musk said earlier this month that the first Starship to Mars would be launched in two years. Now he said the timing of the first crewed mission will depend on the success of the uncrewed flight. Crewed missions will be launched in four years if the unmanned missions land safely. Musk said crewed missions would be delayed by an additional two years in case of difficulties.
- ◆ **Uttarakhand Governor Lieutenant General Gurmit Singh approved a bill that will enable full recovery of damage caused to public property during riots or protests.** The Uttarakhand Public and Private Property Damage Recovery Bill was passed by the state assembly in August 2024. It will act as a strong deterrent to potential offenders who damage public property during strike protests or riots. The main objective of the bill is to prevent people from damaging public property during riots.
- ◆ **The Indian Council of Medical Research has received the United Nations Inter-Agency Task Force Award for 2024.** ICMR has been recognised for its contribution to the advancement of regional efforts aimed at mental health, prevention and control of non-communicable diseases, and the broader Sustainable Development Goals related to NCDs. The honour reflects ICMR's creative work in assistive technology, developing solutions that are affordable, accessible and long-lasting.
- ◆ **The United States, Australia, India and Japan launched an unprecedented effort to help eliminate cancer.** The initiative is part of a broader announcement made at the Quad Leaders Summit. India will contribute \$7.5 million for cancer testing, screening and diagnosis in the Indo Pacific region.
- ◆ **Two new Indian consulates in Boston and Los Angeles have been announced by PM Modi.** As per the announcement, India will open two new consulates in the US, one in Boston and the other in Los Angeles. The consulates will be opened to accommodate the growing Indian American population of the cities. The population of Indian Americans has been increasing in both the cities in recent years. The PM announced the inauguration of the new consulates during Modi and America's event in New York on 22 December 2024.
- ◆ **The Indian Armed Forces under the aegis of Headquarters Integrated Defence Staff conducted the first Tri Services Future Warfare Course.** Conducted under the leadership of Chief of Defence Staff General Anil Chauhan, the course aims to prepare officers for the changing nature of modern warfare. The Future Warfare Course was conducted irrespective of rank, with officers from the rank of Major General to Major General and their equivalent officers from the Navy and Air Force participating.
- ◆ **The US and India have decided to set up a new plant for semiconductor manufacturing.** The new semiconductor manufacturing plant focuses on advanced sensing, communications and power electronics for applications in green energy, next-generation telecommunications and national security. A semiconductor manufacturing plant is commonly called a fab. It is a factory for manufacturing semiconductor devices. The new facility aims to produce silicon carbide, gallium nitride and infrared semiconductors.
- ◆ **The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India and MAPA of Brazil have signed a Memorandum of Understanding in the field of food safety.** During the Global Food Regulators Summit in New Delhi, the MoU was signed by Minister of Agriculture and Livestock Carlos Henrique Baqueta Favaron and FSSAI CEO G. Kamala Vardhana Rao.
