History of 3rd December

- ◆ **1829** : Viceroy Lord **William Bentinck** banned the practice of Sati in India.
- ◆ **1824** : The **British** again besieged the fort of Kittur after summoning reinforcements from Madras and **Mumbai**.
- ◆ **1884** : India's first President **Rajendra Prasad** was born.
- ◆ **1971** : War broke out between **India and Pakistan** which had a devastating effect on the country.
- ◆ **1796** : **Bajirao II** was crowned as the **Maratha Emperor**.

Current Affairs Related to 3rd December 2024

- ◆ **The Union Cabinet has approved the continuation of Atal Innovation Mission with a budget of Rs 2750 crore till 2028.** AIM 2.0 is a step towards a developed India which aims to expand, strengthen and deepen India's already vibrant innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem. India ranks 39th in the Global Innovation Index and is home to the third largest start-up ecosystem in the world. The continuation of AIM will directly contribute to the creation of better jobs, innovative products and high-impact services across all sectors.
- ◆ **The third edition of Nayi Chetna Initiative Badlaav Ki, a national campaign against gender-based violence, was launched by Union Minister for Rural Development, Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan in New Delhi.** Nayi Chetna 3.0 aims to raise awareness about gender-based violence, encourage communities to raise their voices, ensure access to support systems and empower local institutions to take action against violence.
- ◆ **After two decades of negotiations, member countries of the World Intellectual Property Organization adopted the landmark Design Law Treaty.** India signed the Final Act of the Riyadh Design Law Treaty. By signing the treaty, India furthers its progress and reaffirms its commitment to promote inclusive growth. The treaty seeks to harmonize the procedural framework for industrial design protection, improve the efficiency and accessibility of registration processes across multiple jurisdictions.
- ◆ **India has signed the Riyadh Design Law TT which is adopted by the member country of the World Stock Exchange.** This landmark treaty aims to make the Industrial Design Register globally uniform. After nearly two decades of long deliberations, it has been agreed that a new system has been introduced to make property protection simple, efficient and easy for all.
- ◆ **Resident space tech company Techmi2Space India's first space based AI laboratory MOI-TD is set to launch in mid-December 2024 via ISRO's PSLV C60 rocket.** Its mission is largely to enable real-time data study in space, greatly reduce data analysis costs, and make space research accessible to a wider audience.
- ◆ **IIT Hyderabad and Nikon India have joined hands to launch its first Centre of Excellence.** It will provide advanced imaging technology to trainees, visiting scholars and collaborators across the country. It will create an impressive collaboration between IIT Hyderabad researchers and Nikon teams. Nikon India is a 100 percent subsidiary of Nikon Corporation. The Center of Excellence provides a confocal microscope system i.e. AX R microscope with advanced technology.
- ◆ **The Central Government has sanctioned an amount of more than 1115 crores for disaster mitigation and capacity building projects for fifteen states.** A high level committee headed by Union Home Minister Amit Shah has approved this fund. The committee approved Rs 139 crore for Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand and Rs 378 crore for eight states of the Northeast. Karnataka and Kerala got Rs 72-72 crore, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal got Rs 50.50 crore and Maharashtra got Rs 100 crore.
- ◆ **The Indian Coast Guard conducted SAREX 24 in Kochi which is the largest national maritime search and rescue exercise ever.** The theme of SAREX 24 was enhancing SAR capabilities through regional cooperation. It includes live simulations designed to improve the capabilities required for successful search and rescue missions. More than 40 international observers from partner countries participated in the exercise.

It will also carry a large rover weighing 350 kg, which is 12 times larger than its predecessor.

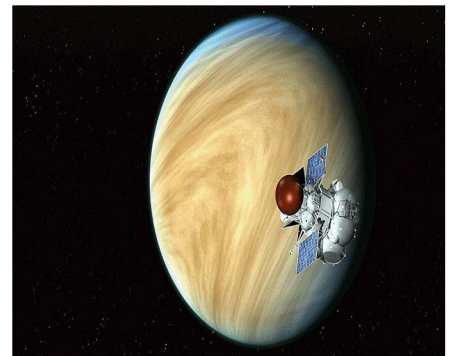
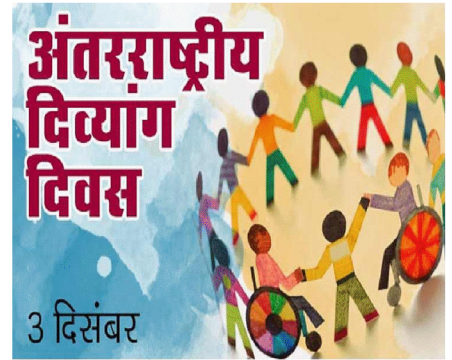

Suryavanshi's base price in the auction was Rs 30 lakh and Delhi Capitals made the first bid. Rajasthan beat Delhi to buy this player.
- 5. Recently, senior IPS officer Deepam Seth has been appointed as the DGP of which state?**
