## History of 30th November

- ◆ **1759** : Delhi Emperor Alamgir II was assassinated by his minister.
- ◆ **1944** : Famous Hindi scientist Maitreyi Pushpara was born.
- ◆ **1965** : Dolls Museum in Delhi was established by Shankar Pillai of the famous Cartoon Building.
- ◆ **2010** : Indian scientist and Swadeshi Movement promoter Rajeev Dixit died.
- ◆ **1931** : Indian historian Romila Thapar was born.

## Current Affairs Related to 30th November 2024

- ◆ **COP 29 set a target of raising 300 billion dollars annually by 2035.** India objected to this agreement and said that it is insufficient for developing countries. Developing countries opposed the approval process of the agreement. They were also against the agreed amount. The countries will coordinate the efforts of all stakeholders to increase public and private funding for developing countries to \$1.5 trillion per year by 2035.
- ◆ **Football and ACC chiefs and ICC President-Elect Jay Shah announced a historic partnership** between the Asian Cricket Council and Sony Sports Network from 2024 to 2031. Under this act, all ACC matches will be broadcast exclusively on Sony Sports Network.
- ◆ **The 40th edition of the Governor's Gold Cup International Football Tournament reached its thrilling peak** at the Paljor Stadium in Gangtok. Northeast United FC added another memorable chapter to the tournament's legacy by securing a dramatic 4-3 penalty shootout win over Gangtok Himalayan Scud. Players of both teams displayed competitive spirit and sportsmanship in the final match in the presence of Chief Minister Prem Singh Tamang and Governor Shri Om Prakash Mathura of the Legislative Assembly.
- ◆ **Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated India's first modern and self-reliant residential Adarsh housing project** at Laltipara in Madhya Pradesh. This Ateli has a flour compressed bio gas plant, which is an important milestone towards India's sustainable development and green energy solutions. This project breaks the vision of Prime Minister Modi's garbage to Kanchan, with the ability to give value to organic products.
- ◆ **The Indian Institute of Science has developed an advanced language called,** which presents the top and structure of technology in a semantic form. This new language has been given a probabilistic form of prediction of the index of Aithpor with the help of learning models.
- ◆ **The United Nations General Assembly Committee passed a resolution to negotiate** the first treaty on preventing and punishing crimes against humanity. This proposal has been unanimously approved by the Legal Committee of the Assembly.
- ◆ **In view of the increasing cases of wrong and private selling in the case of insurance,** the Indian Insurance Company and Development Authority has launched an insurance platform. The aim of this digital initiative is to provide insured products to entrepreneurs. IRDAI Chairman Debashish Panda said on the issue that SBI's annual business and special clause claims that banks should perform their core function i.e. providing loans.
- ◆ **Miss Charm India 2024 finalist and Shivangi Siddiqui, a finalist of the 22nd year** of the Indian Law School of Pune, has made India proud. This December, she represented India at the Miss Form 2024 pageant to be held in Vietnam. Her journey has set an inspiring example of equality, beauty and perseverance, making her a role model for the youth.
- ◆ **India has launched its first artificial intelligence bank, a significant initiative towards promoting** innovation and strengthening national security. This historic move was announced by Union Minister Dr. Amit Shah during the ASSOCHAM AI Leadership Summit 2024. This initiative is part of India's comprehensive strategy, which focuses on increasing the use of AI in economic development and governance.
- ◆ **India's maritime sector is a reflection of its economic progress and global standing.** With a 7,500 km long coastline, 12 major ports and over 200 minor ports, the country conducts a large part of its trade through the seas. SagarManthan Samvad 2024 has further strengthened India's potential to become a global maritime leader, with discussions on sustainability, innovation and focus.

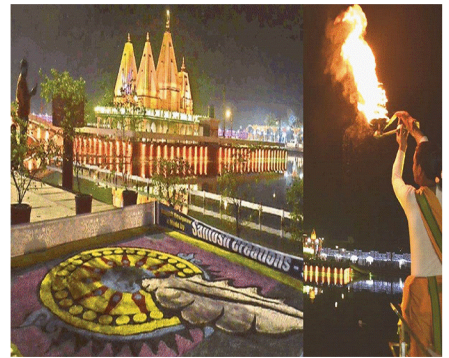

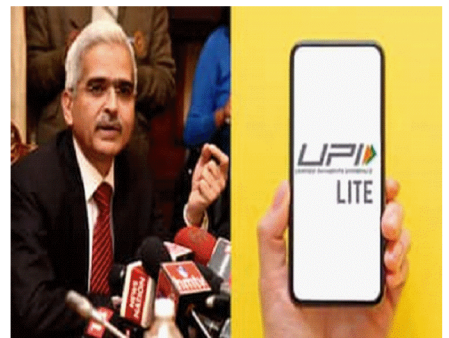

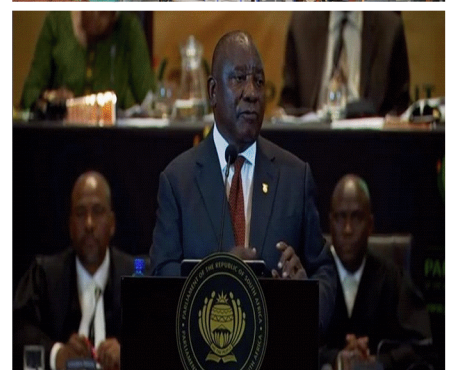


Gwalior Unveils India's First Self-Sufficient Gaushala with a State-of-the-Art CBG Plant
