History of 9th December

- ◆ 1758 : The slow war of the throne of madrasas in India began.
- ◆ 1484 : The great poet Sant Surdas was born.
- ◆ 1946 : The first meeting of the Constituent Assembly was held at the Constitutional Hall in New Delhi.
- ◆ 2009 : Indian tabla player Ustad Hanif Mohammad Khan passed away.

Current Affairs Related to 9th December 2024

- ◆ Chief Minister A. The Revanth Reddy-led Telangana government is going to launch the Raithu Favor scheme after Sankranti, with the target of offering a concession of Rs 15,000 per farmer per annum under the six Congress states. Agriculture Minister T. Nageshwar Rao stressed that Avinash will be as per the report of the Cabinet Sub-Committee. The scheme replaces the previous Raithu Bandhan and efforts have been made to promote it among farmers amid criticism of monkeying it.
- ◆ The new Punjab Bridge is India's first vertical lifter railway sea bridge, located at a distance of 105 years to enhance connectivity between the Indian mainland and Ramsram. This item is a large bachelor in security bridge railway retailer, designed to suit fast speed, and order modern. The bridge, built next to the old Punjaban Bridge, is the first vertical railway bridge in India. Traffic will run at a speed of 80 km per hour on this bridge. Initially, however, the documents will be few.
- ◆ The first edition of CINBAX, a joint table top exercise between the Indian Army and the Cambodian Army, took place in Pune. The Cambodian Army consists of 20 soldiers and an infantry brigade of the Indian Army also consists of 20 soldiers. The exercise also showcased Indian associates and collectives, which will promote self-reliance and indigenous infrastructure in defense production. The first edition of the Ministry of Defense's exercise CINBAX focuses on trust building among soldiers and achieving the spiritual level of differential operations.
- ◆ Grandmaster Arjun Arigasi has created the second Indian bearer history after Viswanathan Anand who crossed the coveted 2800 ELO rating barrier in classical chess. This is the remarkable achievement The 21-year-old player from Warangal in Telangana leads the Republicans as he is ranked fourth in the world with a rating of 2801, slightly below Hikaru Nakamura and Fabiana Karuana.
- ◆ After nearly two decades, acclaimed actor Vikrant Massey has announced his retirement from films at the age of 37. Vikrant, who is known for his multitalented and powerful performances on TV, films and stages, made the announcement through a stainless note. His judgment has left fans surprised and emotional, as he plans to complete two final projects before stepping into 2025. "The last few years and beyond have been bad," Vikrant Macy's official statement reads.
- ◆ Telangana has participated in India's mineral chemistry system and two stone blocks were auctioned at Sultanpur and Saidulnama in November. These blocks, which are critical to the decisive construction, were auctioned to N Club Industries and Deakin Dalai. The move makes Telangana the 14th state to become a part of the Central Mineral Enterprises System. Earlier, the Center had asked Telangana to auction 11 stone blocks, and if the state did not do so, the Center organized the auction itself.
- ◆ The Federal Minister of Finance is to present Banking Law Economics, 2024 at Portfolio Cosom. This includes the Banking Reserve Bank of India Act 1934A State Bank of India Regulation Act 1949A State Bank of India Act, 1955 and Banking Reserve Bank of India Act, 1970 and 1980. These amendments aim to improve the efficiency and regulations of the sector.
- ◆ The tourism sector of West Bengal continues to be recognized internationally, as Darshan has declared it the top target for Heritage Tourism. Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee has made significant progress on religious, heritage and tea tourism in the state. This development has not only created jobs for tourism. Tourism here is being taken to new heights to boost the iconic religious sites and tourist destinations in West Bengal.
