History of 9th November

- ◆ **1236** : Mughal ruler **Ruknuddin Sheikh Shah** was assassinated.
- ◆ **1822** : **Delhi Water Supply Scheme** was started.
- ◆ **1947** : Indian government liberated **Junagadh** through military action.
- ◆ **1889** : Freedom fighter **Jammalal Bajaj** was born.
- ◆ **1941** : Sanskrit language expert **Pandit Ganganath Jha** died.
- ◆ **2000** : **Uttarakhand** was formed as a separate state from **Uttar Pradesh**.

Current Affairs Related to 9th November 2024

- ◆ **Japanese scientists are set to test the world's first wooden satellite.** A team from Kyoto University and homebuilder Sumitomo Forestry has developed the wooden satellite called Lignosat. Lignosat is named after the Latin word for wood. It will be launched to the International Space Station via a SpaceX rocket. It will remain in orbit for six months to test how well the material can withstand extreme environments.
- ◆ **The Madhya Pradesh government has increased the compensation amount for people killed in wildlife attacks from Rs 8 lakh to Rs 25 lakh.** Chief Minister Mohan Yadav said that the families of two people killed in elephant attacks in Umaria will be given an increased compensation of Rs 25.25 lakh. An elephant killed two villagers in Deora village and Brahe village near Bandhavgarh Tiger Reserve.
- ◆ **The International Allied Health Conference was held in conjunction with the 3rd Singapore Allied Health Conference.** 1100 global allied health professionals and students from over 18 countries attended the conference to enhance collaboration and innovation. It is organised by the National University Health System in partnership with SingHealth and National Healthcare Group. The theme of the conference is Advancing Allied Health: Diversity in Calling: United in Purpose.
- ◆ **Renowned fashion designer Rohit Bal, also known as Gudda, passed away due to cardiac arrest** at the age of 63. He is known for his innovative designs and contribution to Indian fashion.
- ◆ **The Madhya Pradesh government has increased the reservation for women from 33% to 35% in all state government services.** This is a big step towards women empowerment in the state. The state government has also approved the opening of 254 new fertilizer sales centers in the state.
- ◆ **In a boost to India's defence capabilities, Pune-based Bharat Forge Limited has bagged the Indian Army's contract for 307 Advanced Towed Artillery Gun Systems.** These advanced artillery systems have been developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisation. Under the contract worth over Rs 6,000 crore, Bharat Forge will manufacture 60% of the 307 howitzer guns. In addition, the second lowest bidder, Tata Advanced Systems Limited, will be responsible for the production of the remaining 40% of the 307 howitzer guns.
- ◆ **A Memorandum of Understanding on bilateral defense cooperation was signed between India and Algeria.** This MoU will enhance defense partnership between the two countries, increase mutual understanding and strengthen strategic interests. Chief of Defense Staff General Anil Chauhan and Chief of Staff of the People's National Army Saeed Chanegriha signed the MoU in the presence of military and officials.
- ◆ **India's first analog space mission has been launched by ISRO to plan lunar mission experiments.** ISRO at Leh will simulate life in an interplanetary habitat. Analog space missions are field tests in locations on Earth. They have physical similarities with extreme space environments. They play an important role in problem solving for space flight research.
- ◆ **Scientists at the Indian Institute of Astrophysics have reported the first significant results from the Visible Emission Line Coronagraph payload of the Aditya L1 mission.** India's first solar mission was launched by the Indian Space Research Organisation on 2 September 2023. The VELC on Aditya L1 accurately predicted the onset time of the coronal mass ejection that erupted on the Sun on July 16. The Indian Institute of Astrophysics, Bengaluru has developed the VELC.

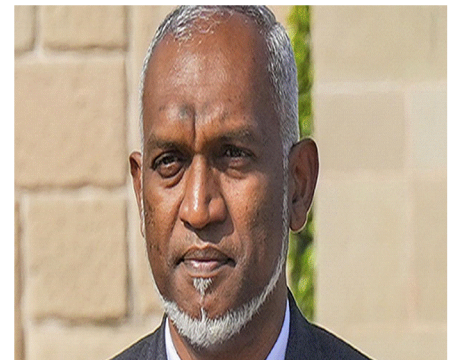

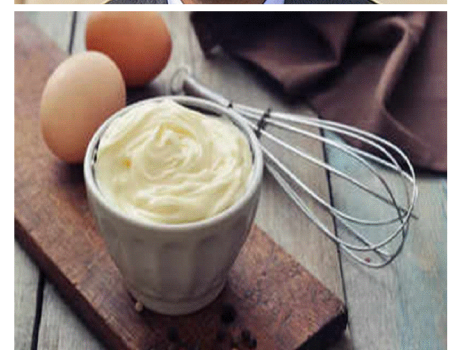

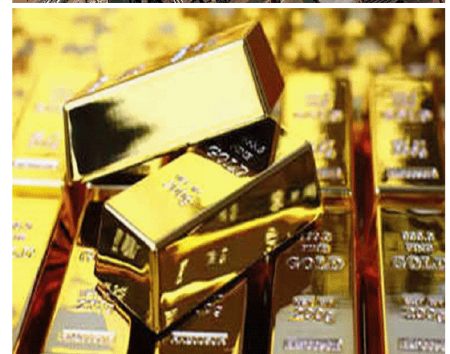
