History of 9th September

- ◆ **1924** : Kohat riots took place in India.
- ◆ **1949** : The **Constituent Assembly** of India accepted Hindi as the official language.
- ◆ **1942** : Famous musician **Mani Madhukar** was born.
- ◆ **2009** : The **Ministry of Railways** announced the introduction of **Bio Business Identification System** for its employees.
- ◆ **1850** : Famous Hindi writer and playwright **Bharatendu Harishchandra** was born.

Current Affairs Related to 9th September 2024

- ◆ **SEBI will soon implement a single corporate filing system across all stock exchanges.** This new system will simplify the process for companies and ensure that investors get timely and consistent information across all exchanges. This will reduce the burden on companies that have to file the same disclosure separately on multiple stock exchanges. This change means that once a company submits a disclosure on one exchange, it will automatically be available on other exchanges.
- ◆ **The World Bank has raised India's growth forecast for FY2024-25 by 40 basis points to 7%** from its previous forecast of 6.6%. The debt-to-GDP ratio is projected to decline from 83.9% in FY23/24 to 82% by FY26/27. The current account deficit is expected to be around 1-1.6% of GDP by FY26/27.
- ◆ **India and Kenya discussed various aspects of defence cooperation during the third meeting** of the Joint Defence Cooperation Committee. The Kenyan delegation met representatives of the Indian defence industry in New Delhi. The two countries discussed issues related to defence cooperation in areas such as military cooperation, training, defence industry, research and development, etc. Defence cooperation between India and Kenya was signed in July 2016.
- ◆ **President Draupadi Murmu has empowered Lieutenant Governor Vinay Kumar Saxena** to constitute any authority, board, commission or statutory body applicable to the Delhi government under any law passed by Parliament. In a notification issued, the Union Home Ministry said that the Lieutenant Governor of Delhi can also appoint members to such authorities, boards, commissions or statutory bodies. This includes the formation of any authority, board, commission or statutory body, or the appointment of any government officer or ex-officio member to such bodies.
- ◆ **Representatives of the Government of India, the Government of Tripura and the NLFT and ATTF** will sign the MoU. The MoU will be signed in the presence of Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah in New Delhi. Tripura Chief Minister Manik Saha and senior officials of the Home Ministry and the Tripura Government will also be present during the signing of the MoU. 12 important agreements have been signed by the government to bring peace and prosperity in the Northeast. Due to signing of agreements, about 10,000 people have given up arms and joined the mainstream.
- ◆ **Defence Acquisition Council approved procurement proposals worth Rs 144716 crore** for the armed forces. The procurement proposal includes future ready combat vehicles and air defence fire control radars for the Army and Dornier radars for the Indian Coast Guard and Dornier 228 aircraft, Next Generation Fast Patrol Vessel and Next Generation Offshore Patrol Vessel for the Indian Coast Guard. The air defence fire control radars will help in detecting and tracking aerial targets and provide firing solutions.
- ◆ **Wokha Sathi WhatsApp Chatbot is an innovative initiative of Wokha District Administration** of Nagaland. Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis presented the award at the 27th National Conference on e-Governance held in Mumbai, Maharashtra. This is the first time that an initiative from Nagaland has been awarded the Gold Award for its contribution to e-Governance. Under this initiative, more than 40 services have been brought under the one stop chat bot of Wokha district administration.
- ◆ **The Super Dimona aircraft simulator has been designed and deployed by the Indian Air Force** Software Development Institute Bengaluru for the National Defence Academy. It will be used by the Air Force training team at NDA to familiarise the cadets with the basic aspects of flying as well as the necessary knowledge of the flight environment. Local private industries were engaged in manufacturing mechanical modifications, flight controls, display screens and other panels as available in the actual aircraft.
